Fridays	6:45 pm - 8:00 pm
Sundays	6:00 pm - 7:30 pm

Public Skate times will be available from October 11, 2016 until March 31, 2017 except when the arena is closed for statutory holidays or during special events.

GENERAL RULES OF PUBLIC SKATING

- No hockey gloves allowed
- Helmets are recommended, skate at your own risk
- Playing games such as crack the whip, tag, etc. will not be allowed
- No sitting on boards
- Skaters must skate in the same direction as everyone else
- No fancy skating or hockey sticks will be allowed during public skating
- No strollers or sleighs
- No pushing people on chairs
- No hockey gloves allowed
- No snowballs
- First time skaters needing assistance use chairs at their own risk
- Seating in guest player box only
- No food or drinks allowed in the players' boxes or ice surface area

Penalties for any infractions will be administered by the Arena Staff and/or the Parks & Recreation Foreman in accordance with the current Recreation Services Discipline Policy.

Boarded Surface - Shinny Hockey

Non-Boarded Surface - 10 & Under Shinny Hockey

Tennis Court - Public Skating (no hockey sticks allowed)

Heated changeroom provided during the hours of:

Monday - Friday:	3:30 pm - 8:30 pm
Saturday & Sunday:	1:00 pm - 6:00 pm

For public safety, the outdoor rinks will be closed when the temperature reaches -40 C
