BYLAW NO. 5/2011  
ASSESSMENT NOTICE BYLAW**

A BYLAW FOR THE CITY OF MEADOW CONCERNING ASSESSMENT NOTICES.

The Council of the City of Meadow Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. TITLE

This Bylaw shall be known and may be cited as the "Assessment Notice Bylaw" of the City of Meadow Lake.

2. SCOPE

This Bylaw shall apply to all land and improvement assessments within the corporate boundaries of the City of Meadow Lake.

3. PURPOSE

In accordance with *The Cities Act*, Section 184(2), this Bylaw authorizes the City of Meadow Lake to dispense with the preparation of assessment notices if the assessed value of a property:

- (a) Has not changed from the previous year's assessed value; or
- (b) The increase or decrease in assessed value does not exceed the lesser of:
  - (i) \$1,000.00 from the previous year's assessed value; and
  - (ii) 1% of the previous year's assessed value.

4. REPEAL

Bylaw No. 3/2006 is hereby repealed.

5. COMING INTO FORCE


This Bylaw will come into force on the date of the third and final reading.


