

**CITY OF MEADOW LAKE  
BYLAW NO. 3/2017  
BUILDING AMENDMENT BYLAW**

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF MEADOW LAKE TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 17/2015 KNOWN AS THE BUILDING BYLAW.

The Council of the City of Meadow Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting hereby enacts as follows:

Bylaw No. 3/2017 is amended in the manner hereinafter set forth:

1. Section 2(1)(w), which reads:

**“Temporary Building”** means a portable structure or enclosure of no more than 55.74 square metres (600 square feet) in building area, including but not limited to shipping containers, cargo trailers and certain other structures that lack permanent foundations. It may also include fabric-covered buildings and recreational vehicles (RVs) as described elsewhere in this Bylaw.

Shall be replaced with:

**“Temporary Building”** means a portable structure or enclosure of no more than 55.74 square metres (600 square feet) in building area, including but not limited to shipping containers, cargo trailers and certain other structures that lack permanent foundations.

2. Section 7(2), which reads:

Temporary buildings may include fabric-covered buildings meeting the following conditions:

- (a) Maximum dimensions of 12 feet in width, 24 feet in length and 9 feet in height;
- (b) Used for storage only;
- (c) Not connected to any services;
- (d) Placed a minimum of 1.2 metres from any building;
- (e) Not located in any front yard; and
- (f) Meeting all Zoning requirements for accessory buildings.

Shall be repealed.

3. This bylaw shall come into force upon the date of passage.

Introduced and read a first time this 13<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2017.

Read a second time this 24<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2017.

Read a third time and adopted this 24<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2017.
