CAPITAL TRUST BYLAW

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MEADOW LAKE TO AUTHORIZE THE CREATION
AND USE OF A CAPITAL TRUST FUND

The Council of the Town of Meadow Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts
as follows:


1. The Town of Meadow Lake hereby authorizes the establishment and maintenance of a Capital Trust Fund under Section 233 of the Urban Municipality Act, 1984.
 - a) The amount of the fund shall be set at one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) and shall be withdrawn from, reduced, increased or replenished at the discretion of the Town Council of Meadow Lake as set forth in the annual operating and capital budget.
 - b) Withdrawals from the fund shall be used for capital purposes only.
2. Bylaws 90/73, 157/75 and 5/78 are hereby repealed.
