BYLAW NO. 09/2002
CROW PEST CONTROL BYLAW**

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MEADOW LAKE TO CONTROL CROWS WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS

The Council of the Town of Meadow Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan under Sections 135 and 137 of the Urban Municipality Act, enacts Bylaw No. 09/2002 a Bylaw to control the crow population within the town limits:

1. The Town hereby authorizes the Municipal Special Constable and or other persons designated by the Town Administrator to discharge low calibre weapons to exterminate crows.
2. Any discharge of weapons will only be allowed between the hours of 4:00am and 7:30am daily.
3. The discharge of weapons on private property will only be approved if the owner of the property gives approval verbally or in writing to allow a town employee access to the lot.
4. This Bylaw will come into force after third and final reading.
