BYLAW NO. 13/2011
BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER BYLAW

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF MEADOW LAKE TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

WHEREAS, Section 8 of *The Cities Act* authorizes a City Council to pass bylaws; and

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Meadow Lake deems it necessary to appoint Bylaw Enforcement Officers.

The Council of the City of Meadow Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be cited as the "Bylaw Enforcement Officer Bylaw".
2. DEFINITIONS:
For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Council" means the Council of the City of Meadow Lake; and
 - b) "Municipality" means the City of Meadow Lake.
 - c) "Bylaw Enforcement Officer" means any person appointed by Council to represent the City, pursuant to Section 337 of *The Cities Act*.
 - d) "City Manager" means the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) of the City.
 - e) "Designated Officer" means any person appointed by the City Manager, pursuant to Section 2 (l) of *The Cities Act*.
3. SCOPE:
 - a) The appointment of Bylaw Enforcement Officers for the City of Meadow Lake shall be by resolution of Council.
 - b) The appointment shall commence on the date indicated in the resolution of Council.
 - c) The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer giving a minimum of two weeks' written notice.
4. DUTIES:
 - a) The duties of the Bylaw Enforcement Officers shall be to enforce the bylaws of the City.
 - b) To represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw;
 - c) The duties of the Designated Officers shall be to inspect bylaw violations and issue warning or violation tickets.
 - d) And other duties as may be assigned by Council or the City Manager.
5. SEVERABILITY:

If a court of competent jurisdiction should declare any section or subsection of this Bylaw to be invalid, such section or subsection shall not be construed as having persuaded the Council to pass the remainder of the Bylaw, and it is hereby declared that the remainder of this Bylaw shall be valid and remain in force.

6. EFFECTIVE DATE:

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the date of the final reading.
