

2017 City of Meadow Lake Photo Contest Showcasing Our Community

The City of Meadow Lake will be launching a new website in 2017, and we need your help to showcase our community. Everyone is invited to participate in our photo contest which will run until April 20, 2017.

Participants must be 18 years or older. Those under 18 may participate if approved by their parent or legal guardian.

Photos must meet the following criteria:

- Image content must be from within or associated with the City of Meadow Lake. Photos can be new or from fifty years ago, as long as they are of the community.
- Photos should be submitted in high resolution jpeg format via email to photocontest@meadowlake.ca along with a completed entry form. Forms are available on the City website or by contacting City Hall. Please don't send files larger than 5 MB.
- Photos should be submitted without watermark overlay. Whenever possible, the City will provide photo credit to the photographer for any images used.
- We welcome photos with people in them, as long as consent has been given by those individuals who are recognizable in the photo.
- Images showing violence, illegal activity, adult content, or other themes considered inappropriate for the purposes of the contest will not be included.

After the entry deadline of April 20th, the City will upload all eligible images to our Facebook page for public voting. The voting period will be open from April 21st to May 8th at noon. After the voting closes, the images with the most likes will be the winners.

Contest winners will be awarded cash prizes of \$100 for first place, \$75 for second place, and \$50 for third place. Photographers may submit up to ten images, but will only be eligible to win one prize.

Any photos submitted will become the property of the City and may be used in future marketing and promotion of the community. Any photos published by the City will include photo credit for the photographer.
