City of Meadow Lake

Conditions to be complied with when conducting a controlled burn within City limits

- **1. Obtain a Burning Permit from the Fire Department prior to burning**. Observe the expiry date on the Permit
- 2. Burn only clean-burning fuels such as dry wood and grass. DO NOT burn synthetics, rubber, or any hazardous material. Verify that no material containing asbestos is burned
- 3. Material to be burned should be piled at least 100 feet away from buildings, vehicles and property lines
- 4. Burn only when weather conditions are suitable:
- low wind
- wind direction is not toward houses or roadways
- 5. Ensure that no fire ban is in effect
- 6. Call the Provincial Dispatch centre before burning: 1-866-404-4911. Advise them of the control burn, including address or land location and your phone numbers
- 7. Attend fire at all times until it is out.
- have sufficient water and shovels on hand to control the fire
- extinguish the fire if winds pick up, become gusty, or change directions so that smoke is blowing toward residences or roadways
- do not leave smouldering fires unattended
- 8. Clean up the remaining debris completely

All Burning Permits are Void when a fire ban is in effect
