

Voter Identification

To vote in the election, a person may present proof of identity and residence before a ballot is issued. You have 2 options for ID:

- One piece of identification issued by the Government of Canada, the Government of Saskatchewan, a municipality, or a government agency that contains a photograph of the voter and his or her name and address. **A valid driver's license or Saskatchewan non-drivers photo-ID, or other Government issued ID that has your name, photo, and current address. If you use your Driver's License for ID, you do not need a second piece of ID.**
- Two pieces of pieces of information, each of which establishes the voter's name and at least one of which establishes the voter's address. Any two listed below is acceptable:

Birth Certificate	Blank cheque bearing the person's name and address

Certificate of Indian Status (Status Card) or Secure Certificate of Indian Status issued by the Government of Canada	a Certification of Identity and Residence that is issued by a shelter, soup kitchen, student residence, senior residence or long-term care facility.
Canadian National Institute for the Blind (CNIB) client card bearing the person's photograph and signature or a card bearing the person's photograph and signature issued by any registered charitable organization that provides services to persons with disabilities	one of the following documents issued by a shelter, soup kitchen, student residence, senior residence or long-term care facility: (a) Letter of Stay (b) Admission Form (c) Statement of Benefits (d) An original or copy of an original document provided by the facility that includes the resident's name, facility address and other relevant information indicating that the individual resides at the facility, such as: (i) a resident data sheet; (ii) a Face Sheet from the Care Organizer Health Record System; or (iii) a similar document that is kept on record by the facility.
Credit Card issued by a bank or credit union	Residential Lease or Mortgage Statement
Debit Card issued by a bank or credit union	Certified copy of title issued by the Registrar of Titles
Identification issued by the Canada Border Services Authority	Certificate of vehicle registration issued pursuant to The Traffic Safety Act
Identification issued by Canadian Air Transport Security Agency (CATSA)	Correspondence issued by a post-secondary institution regulated by a Saskatchewan Act

Identity Card issued by the Canadian Forces	Declaration witnessed by a notary public or Commissioner for Oaths
Employee card issued by the Government of Canada, Saskatchewan, a Saskatchewan municipality, a school division or an Indian Band in Saskatchewan, or an agency of one of these entities	Government cheque or cheque stub issued by the Government of Canada, Saskatchewan, a Saskatchewan municipality, a school division or Indian band in Saskatchewan, the Métis Nation - Saskatchewan, or an agency of one of these entities
Firearm Possession and Acquisition Licence or Possession Only Licence issued pursuant to the Firearms Act	Documents issued by a utility that supplies telephone, cable television, electricity, gas, or water services
Hunting, Angling and Trapping Licence	Income Tax Assessment Notice issued by the Canada Revenue Agency
Hospital bracelet/Hospital card	Document issued or certified by a court in Canada
Métis Nation Status Card issued by the Métis Nation – Saskatchewan	Insurance policy or Insurance statement
Old Age Security (OAS) Card issued pursuant to the Old Age Security Act	Letter from the Public Guardian and Trustee
Pleasure Craft Operator Card issued pursuant to the Canada Shipping Act	Pay cheque or pay receipt issued by an employer
Parolee identification card or other identification card issued by an institution under the authority of the Commissioner of the Correctional Service of Canada	Statement of government benefits (employment insurance, old age security, social assistance, disability support or child tax benefit) issued by the Government of Canada or Saskatchewan
Radio Operator Card or Certificate issued by Industry Canada	Property Tax Assessment Notice or a Tax Notice issued by a municipality
Saskatchewan Health Services Card issued pursuant to The Health Administration Act	Voter identification card issued by Elections Saskatchewan or a Saskatchewan municipality that shows name and address.
Social Insurance Number Card issued by the Government of Canada	Statement of Crop Insurance issued by the Saskatchewan Crop Insurance Corporation
Student Identification Card issued by a post-secondary institution regulated by a Saskatchewan Act	Pension plan Statement of Benefits, Contributions or Participation
Union Identification Card	Statement issued by the Worker's Compensation Board
