General Conditions

1. Burn only clean-burning fuels such as dry wood and grass. *DO NOT* burn synthetics, rubber, or any hazardous materials. Verify that no materials containing asbestos is burned.
2. Material to be burned should be piled at least 100 feet away from buildings, vehicles and property lines.
3. Burn only when weather conditions are suitable:
 - Low wind conditions
 - Wind direction is not toward houses or roadways
4. Advise adjacent residents or businesses.
5. **Call the Provincial Dispatch centre before burning: 1-866-404-4911.** Advise them of the control burn, including address or land location and your phone numbers.
6. Attend fire at all times until it is out
 - Have sufficient people, water and tools on hand to control fire
 - *Extinguish the fire if winds pick up, become gusty, or change directions so that smoke is blowing toward residences or roadways.*
7. Do not leave smoldering fires unattended.
8. Clean up the remaining debris completely.
9. **All burning Permits are Void when a fire ban is in effect.**
10. Other Requirements
