## WHAT IS THIS ORANGE CARD?

If an orange card is left on your front door by our Public Works Department, it means that we are kindly asking you to schedule an appointment for essential maintenance on your water meter.

### Why It's Important:

- **Accurate Billing:** Proper maintenance ensures your water meter accurately measures your usage, helping you receive fair and consistent utility bills.
- **Avoid Catchup Bills:** With a properly working meter, you can avoid estimated bills and potential errors.
- **Continuous Service:** Ensuring accurate readings helps prevent any interruption to your water service.

**How to Schedule:** Our Public Works Department can be contacted at the information below to arrange a time for our staff to visit your home. Your cooperation helps us maintain a reliable and efficient water services.



## FROZEN SERVICE LINES

Section 42 of the Water and Sewer Bylaw states that city residents are entitled to one free thaw once per year.

To prevent repeated freezing, the City may authorize or instruct the property owner to connect an approved "bleeder" line or open an approved tap.

If you experience frozen service lines, you will need to contact a plumber to determine the cause and fix the problem.

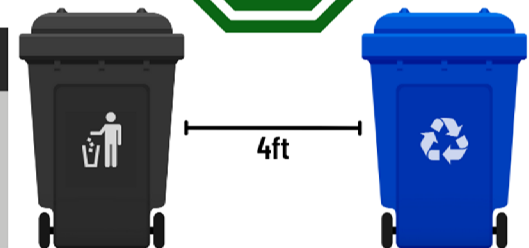

- ### Remember:
- Collection equipment requires clear, safe access to your carts
  - Containers must be placed at least 4 feet away from any buildings, vehicles, other carts overhead and underground utilities
  - Containers with inappropriate materials, or is overweight or overloaded will be bypassed by collection personnel
  - When recycling, break down any cardboard and rinse containers and cans before putting in the bin. Do not bag or tie up recycling.
