WATER SAVING TIPS

There are many ways to reduce water use around your home:

- Install low-flow fixtures, such as high-efficiency shower heads and low-flush toilets.
- Shorten your shower time and reduce the level of water when bathing.
- Fix leaks as soon as you notice them. Fixing leaks could save you about 10 percent on your water hill
- Wash your car at the car wash
- Use a broom when cleaning your driveway or walkway instead of a hose.



CONSERVING WATER DURING LAWNCARE

Spring is upon us which means gardening and lawncare season is almost here. With this typically comes with an increase in your water usage. Here are some tips and tricks you can use to help conserve water:

Avoid watering during the heat of the day or during windy times to minimize evaporation.

Set a tuna can in each of your sprinkler zones and time how long it takes to fill it with water. That's how long you should run your sprinkler once a week if your lawn is dry.

Ensure your sprinklers are working properly and are targeted away from sidewalks. Collect rain water. Rain water contains minerals and nutrients that are good for plants.

Using rain barrels also diverts water away from the City's storm sewer system. Be sure that rain barrels are properly covered to discourage mosquito larvae from developing.
